The Do List

The first thing I do every morning when I arrive at the office is to make a DO LIST. I try to think of all the things that need to be done that day. Usually, there are several notes and pieces of paper

I have written the night before or early in the morning to remind me of tasks at hand. Once the DO LIST is printed, then I start doing. But first, I have to figure out which tasks are most important or pressing.

Sometimes that is easy. Sometimes it doesn't matter. Sometimes it is not clear what to tackle first, second, third, etc. If I just keep pondering the list, nothing gets done. If I take on the easy chores or fun stuff first, I might be ignoring more significant actions. Honestly, some things linger on the list and don't get done for a long, long time.

I'm curious. How do you plan your day? Do you have to make a DO LIST? Do you do it mentally or in writing? (I find that if I make mental notes, I often lose the notes.) How do you decide what is most important? Do you struggle with this process, or is it easy?

In Matthew 6:33, Jesus said to seek first God's kingdom and righteousness and all the other stuff will be ours as well. So God's things should be priority, but how do we do that best? Your feedback and ideas are most welcome!
