Anyone Around You Wilting?

There's a green plant in the hall by the church office; I see it almost every day. When its leaves and stems start to wither and droop, I know it needs water. The poor plant can't speak, so it has to rely on someone noticing its distress. After receiving a good soaking, it is only a couple of hours before the little plant's leaves are full again; its stems have risen, and it looks healthy and refreshed.

There are people around you today who may be withering under the stress of worry, financial problems, grief, depression, or any combination of other difficulties. They may not say a word about their troubles, but if you look carefully and sensitively, you see it. Jesus excelled at reading people and getting to the heart of their problems, even though they themselves did not (or could not) express what was wrong.

So as a Christ-person, look intently at the people God has placed around you. And when you see someone wilting, give him/her a refreshing dose of water... a listening ear, a compliment, an encouragement; send a card, make a call, visit, drop an email. God placed us here, not just to be blessed, but to bless others.
