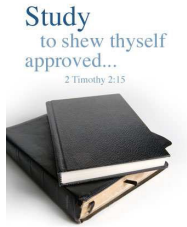

Recharge or Sputter

Electric-powered cars could save us all a lot of gasoline use and expense, but present technical problems include designing battery systems with enough power to carry vehicles long distances. Also, recharging processes are long and problematic. - Cell phones can get trickle charges from car chargers, but they are more fully energized by an overnight plug into home wall-charger.

Human beings need recharging: physically, mentally, and spiritually. Be sure to take ALL your vacation time this year to unplug, disengage, rest. – Working 24/7 for 365 is not admirable, it is dumb. God did not design our bodies to withstand such abuse. Sabbath rest is part of His maintenance program we ignore at our peril.

From July 4 to August 14, I am going to drop the output tasks of ministry and ramp up the input elements of reading, study, prayer, learning, and interaction with other ministers. And I look forward to being recharged on deeper levels of mind and heart. It's a good time in the church life to do this, and you will enjoy the good people who will be sharing messages each Sunday in my absence.
