From the Pastor

Reality-based Faith

One day this summer, our grandchildren were at the house and a Phillies baseball game was on TV. Second baseman Chase Utley came up to bat. Since Debbie knew that Ella and Rocson had recently been to some Phillies games with their parents, she asked four-year old Rocson: "Who is batting right now?" He looked at the screen and said, rather nonchalantly, "**That's Chase, Gran. I've seen him in the real.**"

We have chuckled at Rocson's choice of words and we have appreciated his perception of reality versus TV. Modern life offers many electronically-conveyed experiences, but life at its most significant levels is lived *in the real*.

Should we limit our spiritual input to what we might glean from emails, Facebook, or even devotional magazines, we have chosen a poor substitute for real-life interaction with human beings created in the image of God and struggling to live faithful to Him. **Church is really an action-verb** connoting the dynamic *in-the-flesh* relationships, friendships, and shoulder-to-shoulder working together that humans do with each other every day. Yep, it doesn't always work smoothly. Sometimes it's messy, and sometimes we get on each others' nerves... but it is real!

Hebrews 10:24-25 recognized this truth when it says: "...Let us not give up meeting together... but let us encourage one another..." – That's where I get the most out of the Christian faith; when I am interacting with other believers. And I invite you to and every other believer to do the same: live out your faith engaged in church-life... *in the real*.
