Good Company

Do not be misled: “Bad company corrupts good character.” – 1 Corinthians 15:33

Writing to the believers in Corinth, Paul quoted an old saying which is still true now: Hang around nasty, selfish people and their attitudes will rub off on you. Hang out with good people and you become a better person as well. – Today we say, “You are known by the company you keep.” Or in politics the *gotcha* game is played through “guilt by association.” If a candidate can tie his/her opponent to an unsavory group it erodes the other’s reputation.
