- Powhatan Pharmacy will bill your insurance provider; therefore your co-pay will be whatever your insurance allows.
- All Medicare Part B cardholders and state employees- no charge
- Cost without insurance - \$30.00
- Pneumonia injections will be offered as well.

Ignorance is Expensive!

There is an old saying: **“What you don’t know can’t hurt you.”**

Really? I always thought the *opposite* to be true. Not knowing how to properly use and clean a meat cutting board can result in a royal case of salmonella, or worse. Not knowing the bridge is out on a rainy night means you crash headlong into the river. I read about a family where everyone but the baby was growing deathly ill from a mysterious cause. Finally, it was discovered that a pottery pitcher from which everyone was served orange juice was leeching lead and slowly poisoning them.

Hosea conveyed God’s lament: **“My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge.” – Hosea 4:6.** Indeed, one very helpful thing parents do for their children is to tell them what is safe and what is dangerous.
